



# Support 4-H Youth Golf Tournament

Dear 4-H friend:

We are excited to be holding our 1st annual 4-H Charity Golf Tournament held at Roddy Ranch where we hope to achieve our goal of raising \$60,000 to support the 4-H Youth Development Program in Contra Costa County.

In March, the County Board of Supervisors eliminated 100% of the funding contributed to the University of California Cooperative Extension including the 4-H program. Thanks to the efforts of Supervisor Bonilla and Oakley Council member, Jim Frazier, we received \$50,000 to keep the skeleton of our program alive. This year, we have survived solely on the gracious efforts of a volunteer force.

4-H instills citizenship, leadership, and life skills into future generations through hands-on learning. 4-H involvement makes a difference! In our state alone, 5,900 youth participate in elected leadership roles and volunteers contribute 997,440 hours of community service annually.

A national study by Tufts University showed that compared to their peers, youth who participated in 4-H at least twice per month:

- Show greater confidence
- Earn higher grades
- Are more likely to attend college
- Score higher on civic identity and engagement measures
- Have a greater ability to express opinions on community issues
- Help neighbors and bond with adults and teachers

Within our communities, we help conserve and protect the environment including Marsh Creek, raise money and awareness for charitable causes such as the Contra Costa / Solano County Food Bank, Local Adopt-a-Family, Heifer International and Senior Citizen Outreach, just to name a few, and we have served as leaders through Science, Engineering, and Technology youth training.

Please join us on Saturday, May 15 for a day of golf followed by a delicious Tri-tip BBQ prepared by the Contra Costa Sherriff's Posse. The dinner will be followed a Silent Auction and a Live Auction.

All proceeds from this event will be contributed to the 4-H Youth Development Program, a non-profit organization. Donations to the 4-H program are applied directly to youth activities such as: agriculture, leadership, science and technology, and learning projects.
